Sensitive Data Platform Features and Enhancements

- SDV³: A new tool takes an approach to exhibit reports based on three datapoints: Value, Volume, and Vulnerability
 - This is three-pronged risk assessment tool allows customers to identify the Assets with the greatest risk
 - Manage the Asset to mitigate it in a way that best suits the customer's business needs.
 - A new Dashboard is provided within DAI to display an array of reports and metrics.
- Scan Coverage Enhancement: This feature allows users to assign targets to an asset so that they can effectively track Asset scan coverage. Additionally, this sets the groundwork for SDV3 implementation.

Minor Sensitive Data Platform Enhancements and Work Items Completed for Release

- Allows direct page linking within the application (log in still required)
- Improved Scan Result importing to reduce chances of failed imports
- Returned Assets & Targets menu item to the default Data Asset Inventory menu item
- Updated all tables to have a floating ellipsis menu
- Updated filters across the application to remember previous settings if page is navigated away from
- Updated Oauth process for MIP and Cloud Authentication
- Updated Scan Configuration to allow the option to send the full match, masked matches, or no match if Sensitive Data Finder is disabled
- Updated the Tag Management Screen to show targets more clearly within the tag group

Sensitive Data Platform Bug Fixes

- Some large playbooks are timed out when attempting to load in the UI.
- Resolved some deadlocking issues within the platform database during policy updates
- Updated validation message in User Management's CSV import functionality
- When saving a new classification with **Sensitivity** type selected but is not the type at save, saving failed.
